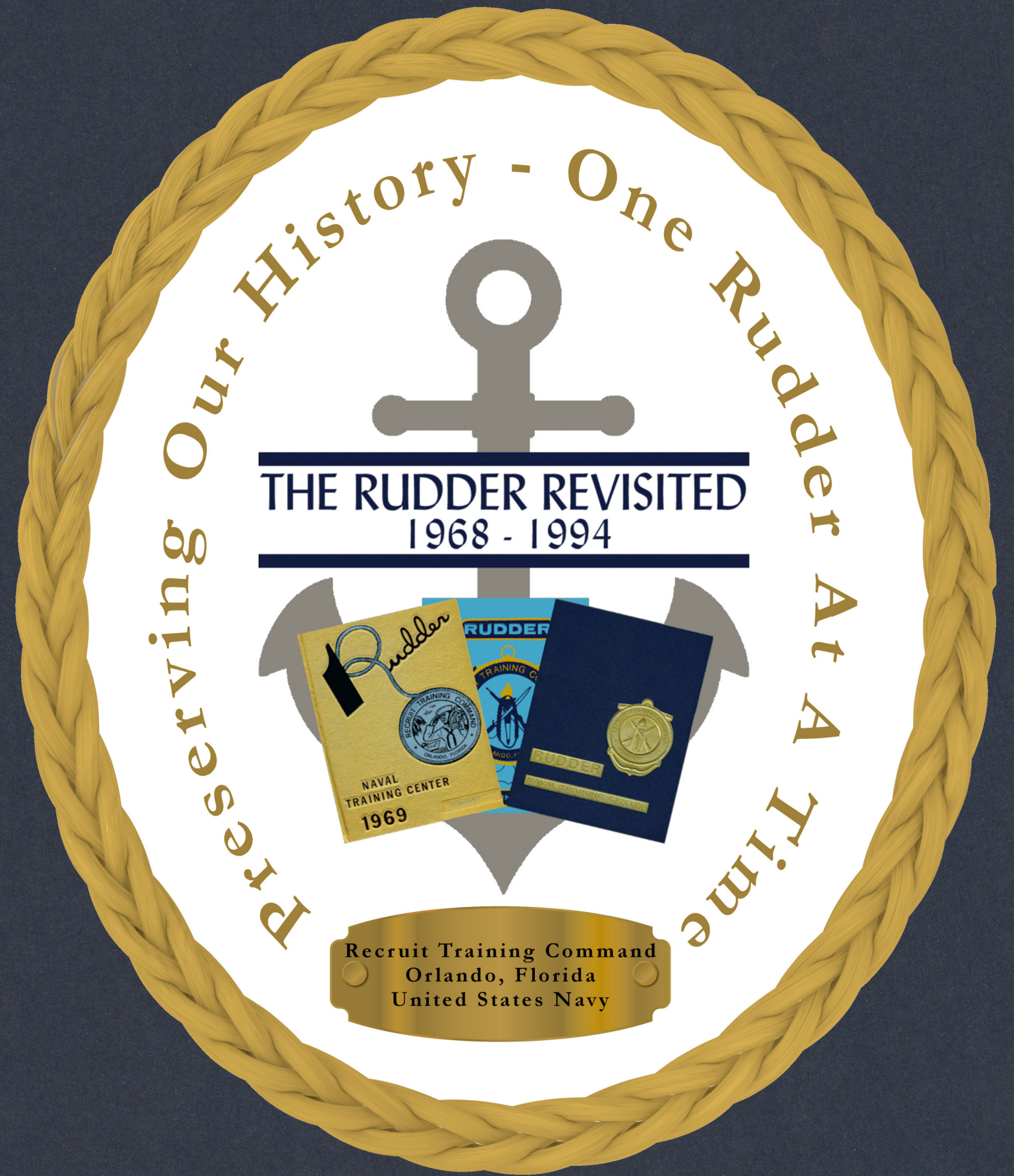

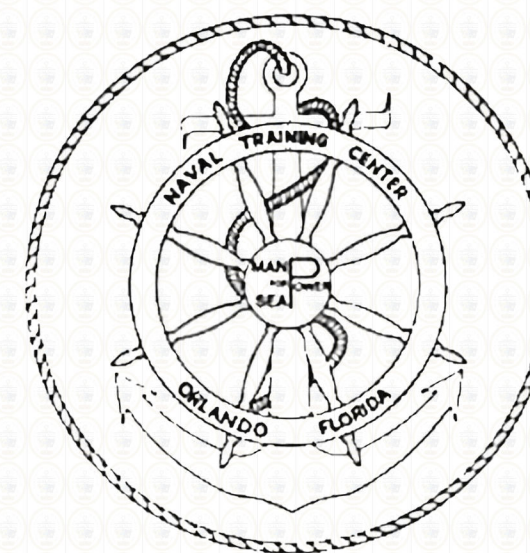
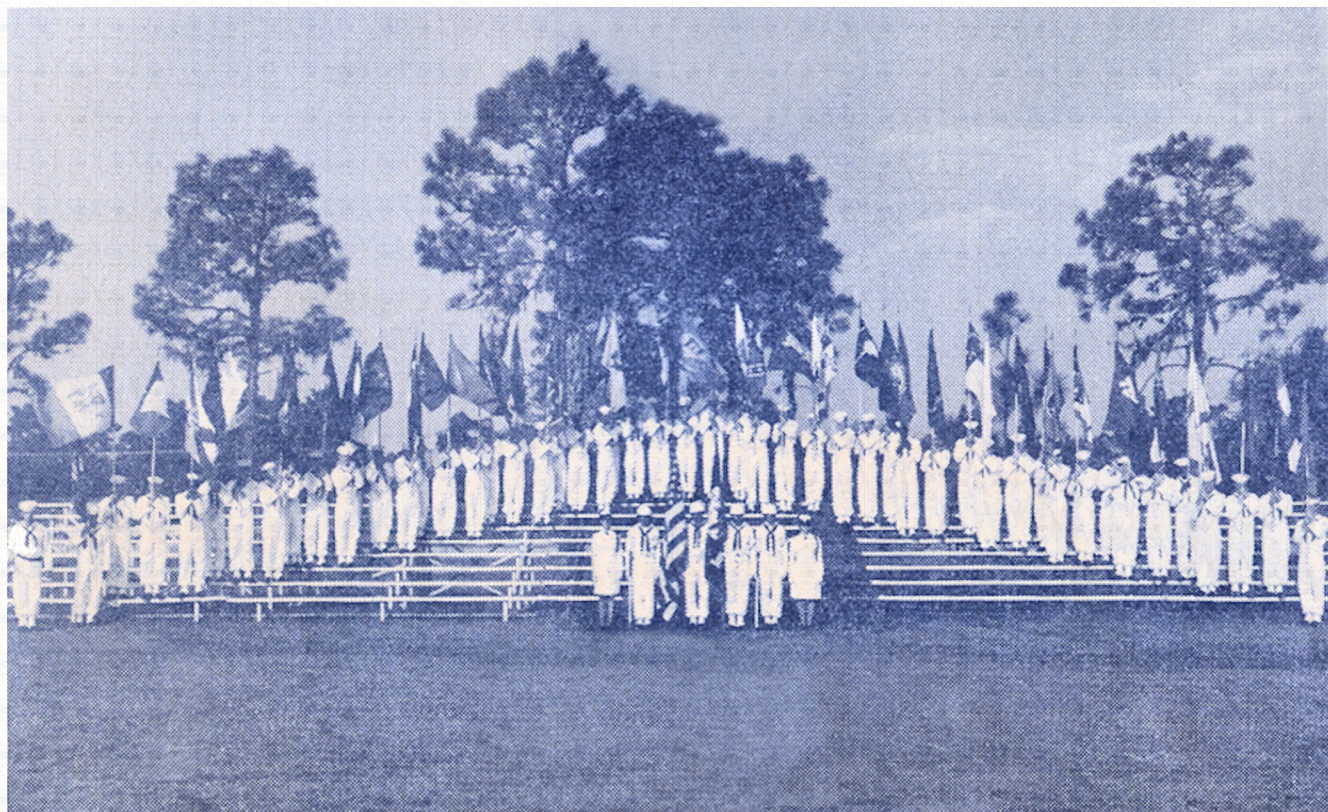

Rear Admiral Albert M. Sackett, a native of Iowa and a former enlisted man, underwent recruit training at the Naval Training Center, Great Lakes, Illinois, and served on several ships before being commissioned an Ensign at the Amphibious Diesel School, Flint, Michigan, in 1944.

Since that time, Admiral Sackett has served as Engineering Officer, Executive Officer, and later Commanding Officer of USS LCI(R) 74; Commanding Officer of LST 990 and LSM 109; Personnel Officer, Staff, Sub-Group FIVE; Engineer Officer and Executive Officer of the destroyer JOSEPH P. KENNEDY; Squadron Engineer, Staff, Commander Destroyer Squadron SIXTEEN; Material and Operations Officer for Commander Destroyer Flotilla FOUR; Operations, Plans and Security Officer, Naval Training Center, Great Lakes; Executive Officer and Commanding Officer of the USS PRESTON; as a student at the Naval War College; as Commanding Officer of the guided missile destroyer JOHN KING; as Commanding Officer of Naval Destroyer School; as Director, Officer Distribution Division, Bureau of Naval Personnel; and as Special Assistant to the Under Secretary of the Navy. He assumed his present assignment as Chief of Naval Technical Training in June 1972. His headquarters are located at Memphis, Tennessee.

Among the Admiral's awards are the Navy Commendation Medal with Gold Star in lieu of second award, the Meritorious Service Medal with Gold Star, the Presidential Unit Citation Ribbon, and various campaign ribbons.

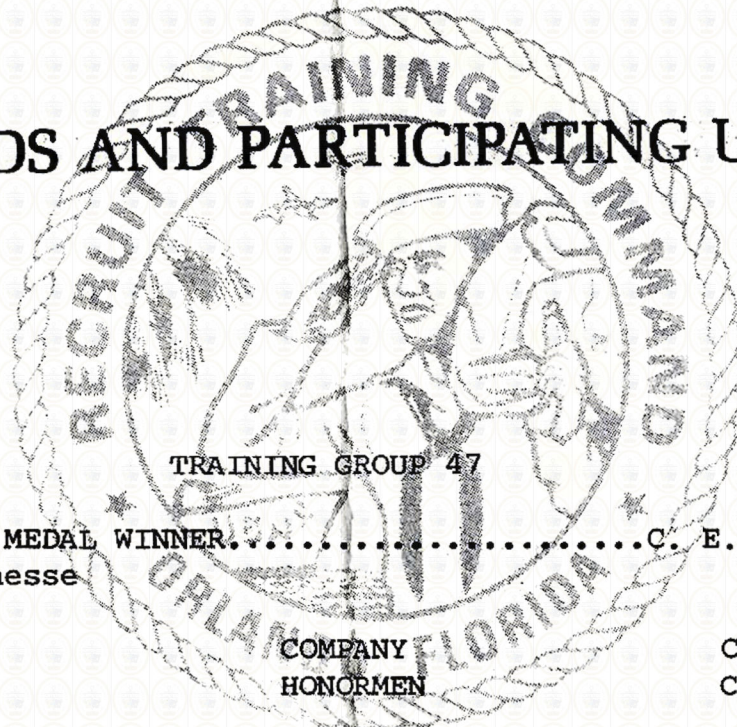

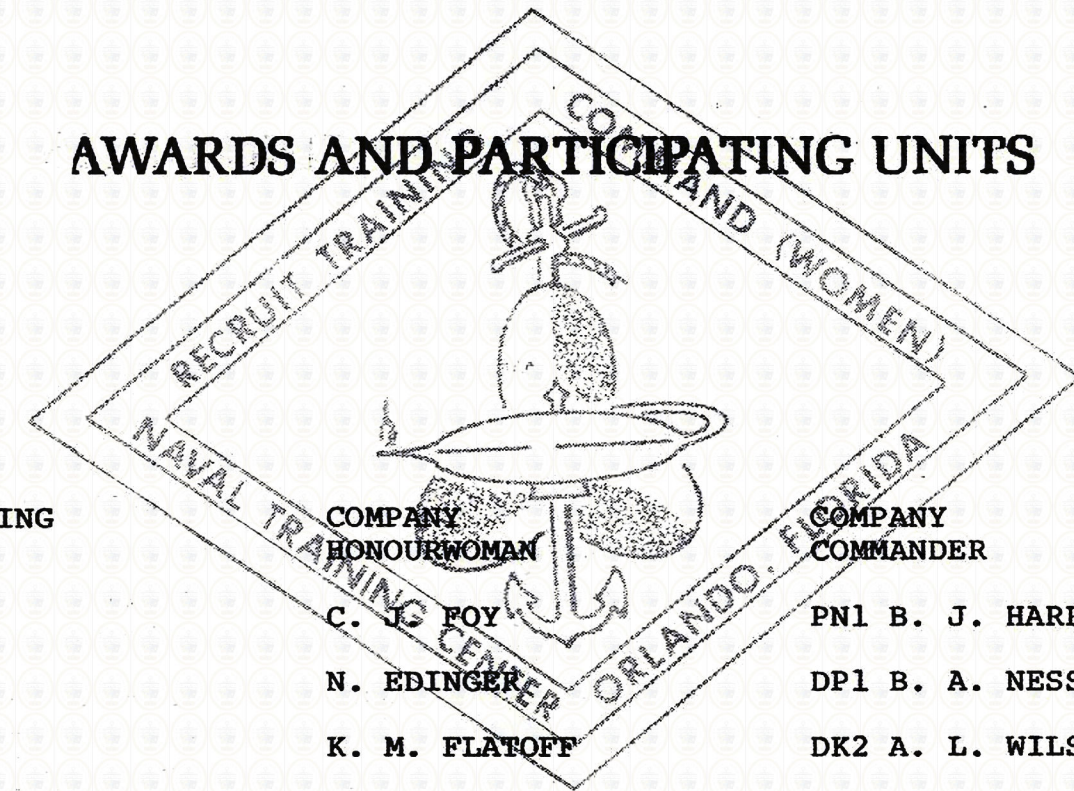
