REVIEWING OFFICER



LIEUTENANT (JUNIOR GRADE) HOWARD L. POVEY
U. S. NAVY, RETIRED
PRESIDENT, YANGTZE RIVER PATROL ASSN.

Lieutenant (junior grade) Howard L. Povey, a native of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, served in the U. S. Merchant Marine as an able seaman before enlisting in the U. S. Navy on November 13, 1923.

After recruit training at the Naval Training Center, Hampton Roads, Virginia, his first assignment was aboard the light cruiser USS RALEIGH.

Subsequent assignments included; as Seaman Second Class aboard the light cruiser USS CINCINATTI in 1924; as Quartermaster Third Class aboard the gunboats, USS HELENA, USS GENERAL ALAVA and USS PANAY through 1928 while in China; as Quartermaster Second Class aboard the heavy cruiser USS CHESTER; onboard the oil tanker USS SAPELO until December 1933, the battleship USS ARIZONA until March 1934, and the fleet tug SUNNADIN in Hawaii until 1936; and, as Quartermaster First Class aboard the destroyer USS WATERS.

Other assignments were: student at the Recruiting School at Norfolk, Virginia in early 1937; Officer-in-Charge, Recruiting Sub-station, Richmond, Indiana; aboard the battleship USS TEXAS and the fleet tug ONTARIO where he received his permanent appointment to Chief Quartermaster and a harbor pilot's license; Officer-in-Charge of the oil barge YO-68 from May 1943 to September 1944; and aboard the fleet tug ACHOMAWI where he was promoted to Chief Boatswain's Mate.

Lieutenant (junior grade) Povey was promoted to his present rank (temporary) on July 26, 1945, and transferred to the Fleet Reserve on July 7, 1945, with 22 1/2 years of service.

He received orders to return to active duty in 1950 and served as a Chief Quartermaster at the Recruit Training Command, Great Lakes, Illinois, before being transferred to the retired list on November 30, 1953, with 30 years of service.

Lieutenant (junior grade) Povey graduated from the University of Florida with a BSA degree in January 1961. He retired from the University in 1971 as a Laboratory Technologist and now substitute teaches in Hernando Beach, Florida.

His membership in many civic, social and military organizations includes the Retired Officers Association and the Fleet Reserve Association. He is the current President of the West Hernando Business and Civic Club.

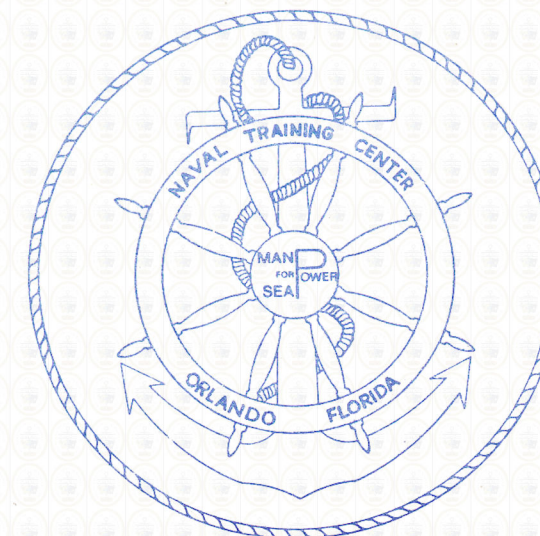
